

## Resume Page

The recipe page assignment is useful for practice, and important in the learning process, but now let's apply these skills to something more useful — your résumé.

Résumés are built from the same elements we've covered in this session: headlines and subheaders, paragraphs, and lists. Follow these steps to create your résumé, just like you did with the recipe:

1. If you don't have a résumé yet, go write one, silly! If you want more to put on it, mke things up. That's okay for this assignment espically if they are outrageous!
2. Copy and paste your existing résumé text into a JS Bin.
3. Add appropriate HTML tags (including `<h1>`, `<h2>`, `<p>`, `<ul>`, `<li>`, and others).
4. Add CSS style to clean the spacing (including margin and padding).
5. Add CSS color in a very subtle manner or not at all — remember, this is a résumé!  
Note: We have not yet covered how to create multiple-column layouts, or how to insert images onto a web page. So, this version of your résumé won't contain multiple columns or images.
