

Muse Notes:

Create a new site.

First, normally you would create a page in photoshop first.

Muse lets you by-pass this step.

File > New site > New site Dialog Box.

Initial Layout > Phone, tablet or desktop. (mobile first or desktop for new learners)

Width— target the resolution of the device you are designing for. 1024 pixel width for desktop computers leaves you about 960 after you subtract scrollbars, browser sidebar, everything else (not set in stone! and you may know your typical viewer has more resolution, and design specifically for them.

Minimum height: 500 pixels. Now the conventional site uses scrolling, so your viewers will be familiar with scrolling, so the page can be more than that. But certain things really should appear before scrolling, like the navigation, and if there is a central image.

Notice there is no unit of measure??? You cannot change it to inches because???
Everything is Pixels, of course!

On the right, you can set up the grid you want.

Remember how the margins and padding work on html elements? Here is the margin and padding for the <body>, that is for the overall page. These are locked but can be unlocked to be individually sized. Notice how the margins you give it affect the size of the column width we last looked at. That's because this is being mathematically calculated as you change the numbers, to be even columns.

Padding > you have the option of centering horizontally. the left padding is here, meaning the right would be indefinite, as the viewer's screen size could vary.
